The WWI happened along with the end of the modern Globalization, (the end of the Belle Époque, 1914), and the last 3 under the contemporary Globalization started with the 1918 influenza Pandemic.

By the way we must keep in mind that the Globalization exists since almost 6.000 years and the origin was inside the network of megalopolis in Mesopotamia.
